Please let friends and family know who are considering Lanesville Community School. We will be hosting our Kindergarten Round-Up April 11th starting at 8:30 by appointment (see sign up steps below). The student will need to be 5 years old on or before August 1, 2019.

Please bring:

The day of Round-Up parents will need to bring a copy of the student's state certified birth certificate (certificates issued by the hospital are not acceptable), immunization records, and a utility bill (proof of residency) & Court Documents (If you are a single parent or guardian please provide the documents for prove parental or educational rights) Students who have not completed the immunization requirements for school entry will be allowed to register, but must be in compliance with state law by the opening of school in the fall. The Harrison County Health Department may be contacted at 812-738-3237 for information about vaccines and cost.
