Here are some other scholarship opportunities:

1) MAC Construction Scholarship- for graduating seniors with at least a B average and are pursuing higher education in Civil Engineering, Construction Management, Mechanical Engineering or Mechanical Engineering Technology. They are due to Mrs. Morgan by the AM of March 22 in person or can be scanned and emailed to Mrs. Morgan by the 29th. I have applications in my office to pickup.

2) United Producers, INC.- Must be a member or a child/grandchild of a UPI member. Members market at least one head of livestock at UPI per year and will be based on 2018 records. Must be a 2019 graduate enrolled in a college or technical school studying an agricultural-related field. Applications are in Mrs. Morgan's office and must be postmarked by April 1.

6) Harrison County Hospital Foundation scholarship- must have graduated within the last five years and from Harrison and Crawford counties in Indiana and Meade County in KY. 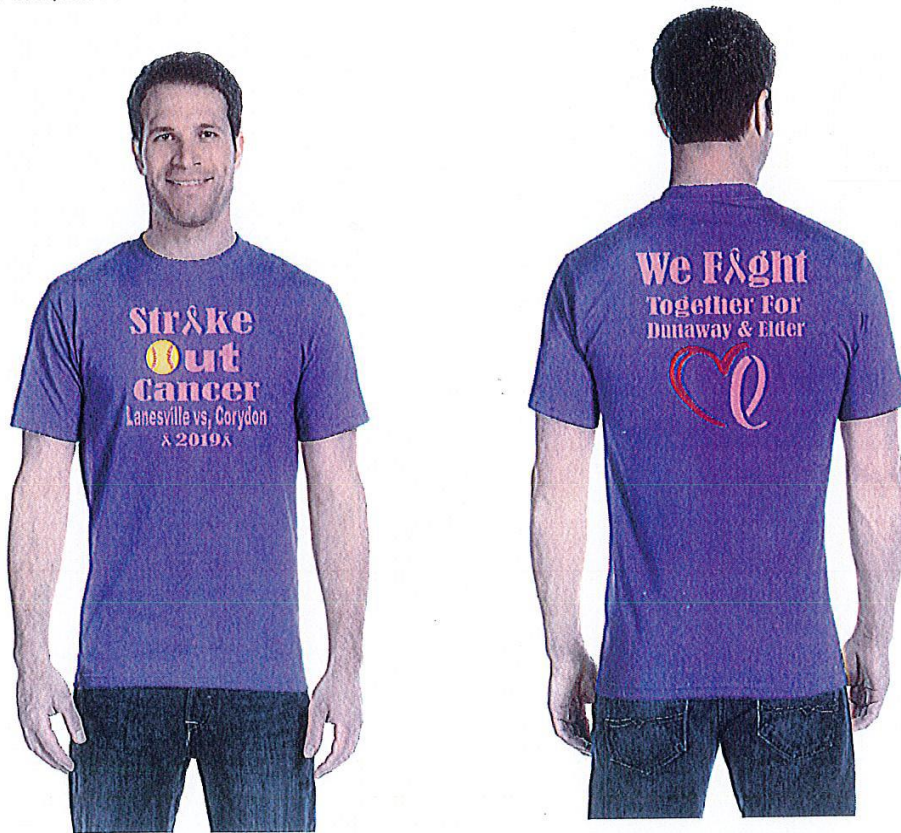

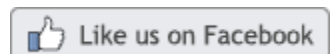
