Please let friends and family know who are considering Lanesville Community School. We will be hosting our **Kindergarten Round-Up April 11th starting at 8:30 by appointment** (see sign up steps below). The student will need to be 5 years old on or before August 1, 2019.

### Please bring:

The day of Round-Up parents will need to bring a copy of the student's state certified birth certificate (certificates issued by the hospital are not acceptable), immunization records, and a utility bill (proof of residency) & Court Documents (If you are a single parent or guardian please provide the documents for prove parental or educational rights) Students who have not completed the immunization requirements for school entry will be allowed to register, but must be in compliance with state law by the opening of school in the fall. The Harrison County Health Department may be contacted at 812-738-3237 for information about vaccines and cost.

# HARRISON COUNTY HOSPITAL

## FREE SPORTS PHYSICALS

Local primary care providers donate their time to offer free sports physicals for student athletes entering grades 6 thru 12, who live in Harrison or Crawford counties.

The Harrison County Health Department will also be on hand to administer ACIP recommended immunizations. Those who have insurance coverage will be billed and those who do not will be administered free of charge. Consent forms must be signed by parent to receive vaccines. Parents should bring an updated shot record for your child.

Appointments are on a first-call-first-served basis. Appointments will be taken until the schedule is full.

Athletes must bring their IHSAA Pre-Participation Physical Evaluation Form, with parent and student sections completed, the completed Vaccine Consent Form and current shot record if vaccinations are needed.
