FREE SPORTS PHYSICALS

Local primary care providers donate their time to offer free sports physicals for student athletes entering grades 6 thru 12, who live in Harrison or Crawford counties.

The Harrison County Health Department will also be on hand to administer ACIP recommended immunizations. Those who have insurance coverage will be billed and those who do not will be administered free of charge. Consent forms must be signed by parent to receive vaccines. Parents should bring an updated shot record for your child.

Appointments are on a first-call-first-served basis. Appointments will be taken until the schedule is full.

Athletes must bring their IHSA Pre-Participation Physical Evaluation Form, with parent and student sections completed, the completed Vaccine Consent Form and current shot record if vaccinations are needed. Forms are available at your participating school, the Harrison County Health Department or online at www.hchin.org/sportsphysicals or www.harrisoncountyhealth.com.

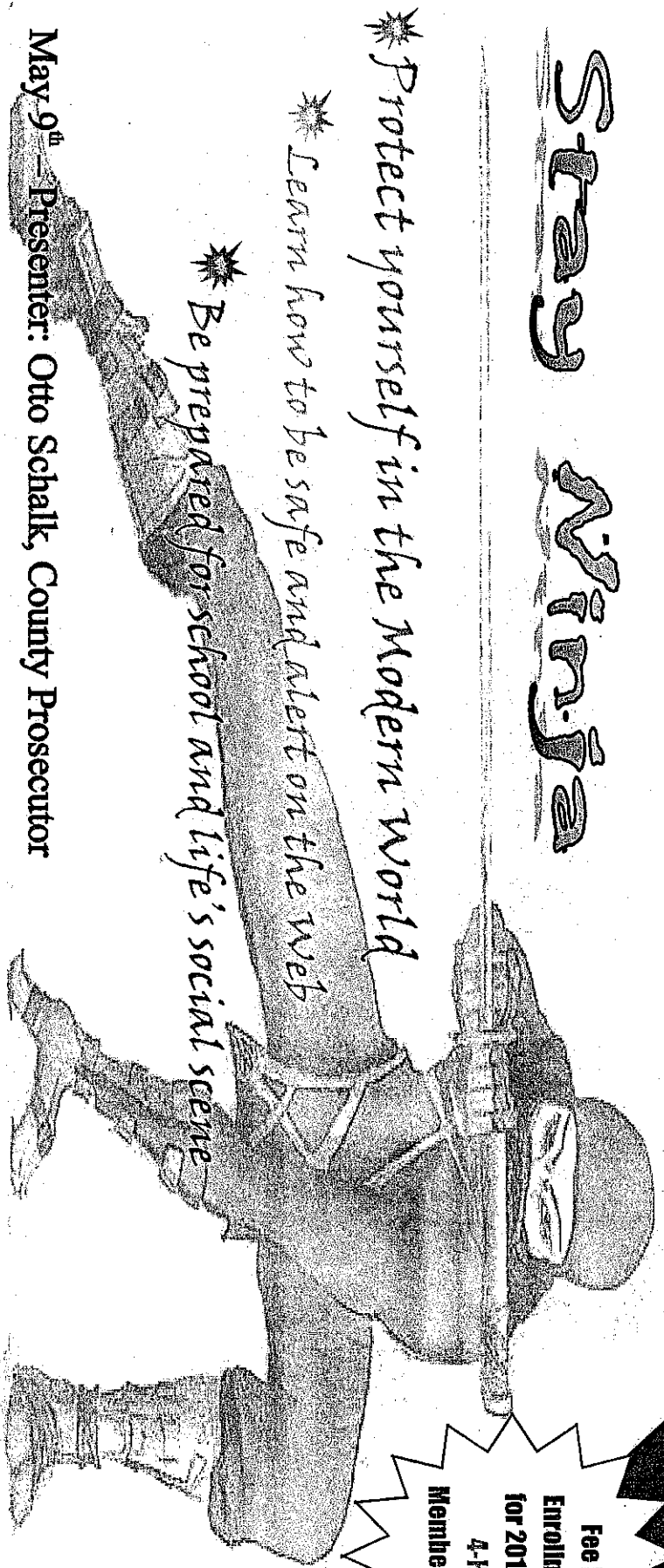

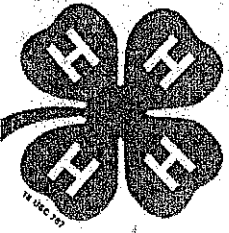

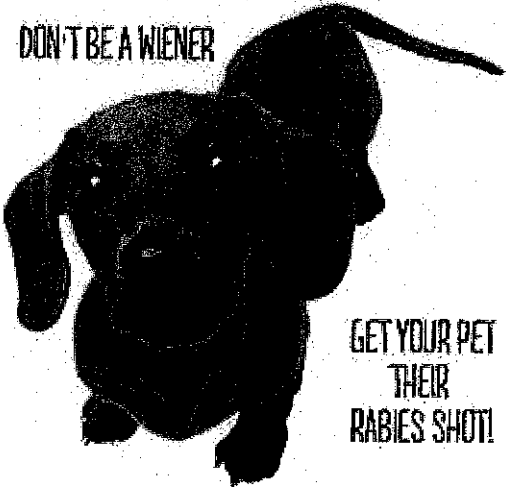
