FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Welcome back to the 2019-2020 school year. We have a lot of new faces and with new faces comes a lot of new information. First, please make sure that if you drop off students in the morning you must drop in the car rider line unless it is after 7:55 am. If students are tardy (after the bell rings at 7:55), you must bring them into the office to sign them in. Also please remember to pull all the way forward to the first available space when dropping off students each morning. Parents are not to walk students to the car rider door. If students need assistance, someone will come to the car to help.

Please make sure you check the guidelines in the student handbook (located on the school webpage under the elementary tab) for bringing treats into the building. If you bring in birthday treats for the class, you must contact the teacher a week in advance. All treats brought in to the school must be store bought and have a list of ingredients clearly labeled so our school nurse can check the ingredients for student allergies.

ENTERING THE SCHOOL BUILDING DURING THE DAY

For the safety of our students, please be aware that if you come into school during school hours (7:30-3:00) and are entering anywhere in the building aside from the main office you will be asked to give the office a valid driver's license/state ID to sign in. If you arrive before 7:30 and are going to be in the building after 7:30 we ask that you RETURN to the office and sign in. Once your ID is scanned into our system it should save your ID information but that does not happen in all cases.

Please make sure to bring your ID into the building and have it with you at all times.
