Lunches and Visitors to the building

Due to the large number of students in our lunches we do not allow parents/friends, etc to visit during lunch for grades 7-12.

Also unless a visit is arranged in advanced, we ask that no one stops by to visit classrooms. It creates a distraction in the classroom if the teacher is not expecting a visitor. If you visit the building and are going past the front door for **ANY REASON, then YOU MUST sign in at the office.** You will be asked to provide the office with a state issued ID to be scanned and a visitor sticker printed. This sticker should be worn at all times while in the building.

Online Registration

Thank you to everyone who has already completed the online registration. So far the completion rate has been much better than years past. If you have not already done so, please log into your child/children's Harmony account and complete online registration. Online registration helps eliminate paperwork and the chance of forms not making it home or back to the office. Please note, if you set up a log in from last year that log in will still work, DO NOT create another account. Free and Reduced Lunch

If you have not already done so and intend to please go online and complete the application for free and reduced lunches. You can log into harmony, go to online registration, and at the bottom of the forms there is a link to the Application for Free and Reduced Lunches.

Student Drop off & Pick up

For the safety of students and staff we have set drop off and pick up procedures.

AM Drop off – Between the times of 7:35 and 7:50, Jr/Sr High Students will need to be dropped off at the north side of the parking lot, away from student drivers and busses, and walk across the lot. No students are to be dropped off at the entrances of the school during this time. If students arrive at school after 7:55 a.m., they are considered tardy and must sign in at the office.

PM Pick up – No students should be picked up at the front of the building during dismissal until the buses have exited the parking lot. After buses have left students may be picked up at the school entrance. Jr/Sr High School pick up is on the south side building, at the downstairs double doors past the elementary car rider line.

Do not pick up or drop off your child at the curb near the main entrances when busses are present before or after school.

Picture Day

Picture day is scheduled for the Jr/Sr High School for Thursday, August 22nd. These are pay in advance pictures. All students will have their picture taken even if pictures will not be purchased and this picture will be in the yearbook. Picture forms will be handed when we have them available

Prosser Students

Prosser students need to have parents inform Prosser directly for their absences through their attendance line, 812-542-6601. The AM Prosser bus will leave school by 7:30 AM. On days that we are NOT in session and Prosser is in session transportation will not be provided from the school. Prosser students are NOT to drive to Prosser unless permission has been given by Prosser and Lanesville has been notified by a parent/guardian of the student. Prosser enforces this policy and students must sign in at student services and obtain a proper parking permit.

Sign up for Athletic Event Notifications!

The Athletic Department switched scheduling programs for all sporting events last year to Eventlink. This program allows parents/members of the community to sign up for a free account and get notifications for the sports that you would like, access to a free app, import to your Google calendar, etc. You can sign up for an account at www.Eventlink.com. Below are some instructions on how to link the event calendars once you set up your online account. There is also a Free App available.

Signing up for an Eventlink account (One time initial set up):

Go to www.Eventlink.com

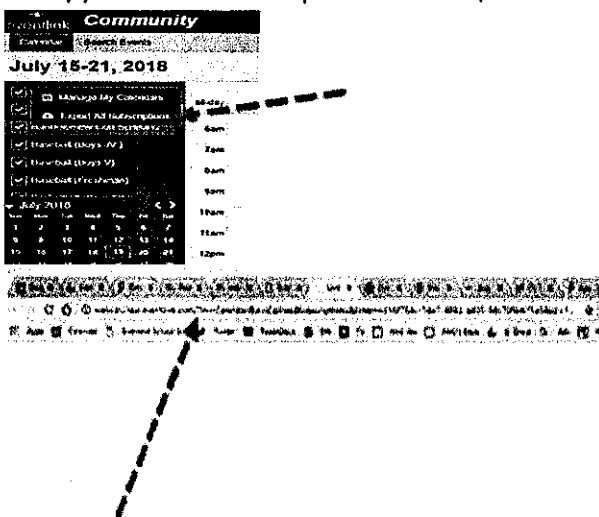
Click create an account

Search school by name or zip code. Lanesville Jr/Sr High School will populate in the available schools. Click the plus to the right of the school name. This will move the school into "my subscriptions". You can click or unclick the box for notification and daily summary. Click the green "next" button on the bottom right of the screen. You will then complete registration by filling in your name, user name, and password, and add contact email. An activation code will be emailed and you will put that code.

Once your account is set up you can log in and manage your calendars. Add or delete teams as you like.

To get your iCal link:

1. Click on "My Calendars."
2. Click "Export My Calendars," this will open a new blank tab.
3. Copy the URL at the top of the screen, and add it to the calendaring app of your choice.



Further instructions for Google Calendars, Outlook, and Apple calendars are below.

Iphone:

1. Tap the 'Settings' app
2. Tap 'Calendars'
3. Tap 'Accounts'
4. Tap 'Add Account'
5. Tap 'Other'
6. Under 'Calendars', tap 'Add Subscribed Calendar'
7. Enter the link from the blank tab that opened when clicking 'Export My Calendars'
8. After the server address is verified, you can edit the calendar name in the 'Description' field.
9. Tap 'Save'
10. Your calendar should now appear in the 'Calendar' app

Outlook 2016:

1. Copy the link from the blank tab that opened when clicking 'Export My Calendars'
2. Open Outlook 2010
3. Click 'File' to open the 'Account Information' page
4. Click 'Account Settings' and then select 'Account Settings' from the list.
5. Click the 'Internet Calendars' tab and click the 'New...' button.
6. Paste the link to your iCal feed in the location field and click the 'Add' button.
7. Enter a name (folder name) for your calendar and a description, if you so choose.
8. The 'Update Limit' checkbox should be checked.
9. Click the 'Ok' button and then click the 'Close' button, to close button on the 'Account Settings' window to finish.
10. Your calendar should now be imported. If you do not see your calendar or events, you may need to check the calendar name, located under the 'Other Calendars' heading on the left-side of the application.

Google Calendars/Android:

1. Open <http://calendar.google.com> in a web browser.
2. Along the left side of the calendar, click on the dropdown arrow under 'Other Calendars'
3. Select Add by URL
4. Copy and paste the link from the blank tab that opened when clicking 'Export My Calendars'
5. Click Add Calendar
6. Your calendar will now be found under 'Other Calendars'
