### Enhanced Cleaning Protocol

- Increased number of hand sanitizer stations in key locations
- Front Offices will have barriers and/or windows installed for safety
- Safe, effective cleaning products used on schedule throughout the day at all high touch areas in school/classroom and on bus.
- Intense cleaning nightly

### Covid Positive Protocol

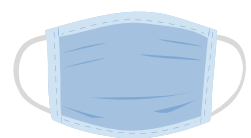
Individuals will be quarantined for 14 days before returning to school. Contact tracing will be conducted by the Harrison County Health Department.

### Other Illnesses

Students must be fever-free for 72 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication and a release from a doctor OR symptom free for 14 days.

## Health & Safety Protocol

### • MASKS



It is highly recommended that students have masks with them. There may be situations when masks will be required, such as on the bus.

### • TRAINING

Professional development will be provided to all staff before school begins on symptoms and screening measures.

### • DIVIDED CLINIC



There will be an area for ill students and a separate location for medication, etc.

### • SEATING CHARTS



Seating charts will be required on buses, in classrooms, and the cafeteria. Siblings will be seated together on buses.

### • WATER BOTTLES



Students will be allowed to carry water bottles. Only water bottle filling stations will be available; water fountains closed.

### • HAND WASHING

Hand washing will be required throughout the day. Hand sanitizer will be available.

# Changes to the Classroom/School Environment

## CLASSROOMS

- Changes will be made to classrooms to create more personal space (i.e. reduce furniture, etc.).
- Students will face the same direction in classrooms as much as possible.
- Students will use their own supplies to minimize sharing of supplies.

## CAFETERIA

- Adjustments made to lunch schedules
- An extra lunch period added for Jr/Sr High
- Extra time between lunches for additional cleaning
- K-2 students will eat in classrooms
- Lunchbox students in grades 3-6 will eat in classrooms
- Seating charts will be used

- No external field trips until further notice.
- Visitors/guests who must enter the school (i.e. to pick up a student) will be limited to the main office and recommended to wear a mask.
- Volunteers (during the day) MUST be scheduled and approved.
- **K-6 classes will have recess on the playground** *\*weather permitting*

## 100% VIRTUAL LEARNING STUDENTS

- Virtual learning students will participate daily via Live Stream, will follow the regular daily schedule, and daily attendance will be taken. Daily interaction with teacher(s) is expected.
- **Virtual Learning is for Covid-19 concerns ONLY**
- **Students participating in Virtual Learning MUST have Internet access**
- Students participating in Virtual Learning must participate in mandated assessments
- Students participating in Virtual Learning will not be permitted to participate in extracurriculars
- Virtual Learning will be evaluated at the end of the first semester

## OTHER PREVENTION ITEMS

- Families must screen their children and keep them home if ill. Sick children will be directed immediately upon arrival to the nurse who will require him/her to be picked up.
- Perfect attendance incentives for the 2020-2021 school year are eliminated for students and staff.
