Mrs. Steele's Counselor's Corner

Hi LES Families! Happy Heritage Week!

This week, I met with 4th, 5th and 6th graders to continue lessons and conversations about bullying. 4th grade: Building on the last lesson, Bully Beans, we began talking about what truly defines a bullying situation. We discussed the criteria 1) on-going/repeated, 2) on purpose with the intent to be mean, and 3) it's difficult to stop (power imbalance). Lastly, we focused on the difference between a mean moment, conflict, and bullying. Students were surprised to learn that oftentimes, situations really are just mean moments, and while they are hurtful, they can be easily resolved!

5th grade: This week, we began talking about cyberbullying. Students were already aware of what cyberbullying was, but we had a really thoughtful and mature conversation about how much it affects youth. We even signed a class cyberbullying contract and all agreed to be good digital citizens! Next guidance, I will be tasking them with creating their own (pretend) social media app that is bully free! I cannot wait to see where their creativity takes them

6th grade: This was such a fun week for 6th grade! Each class broke up into 4 groups and were tasked with some "cyberbullying research." They had to use their skills to delegate, compromise, and find their own information on a topic they didn't know. Next guidance, they will make awareness posters to reflect their topic information and present them to 5th graders!

I hope everyone has a safe, fun-filled weekend at Lanesville Heritage!
