We talked about how our brains are similar to rubber bands and have the ability to grow, stretch, and get bigger. Everyone could relate to a time they had a fixed mindset and gave up when things got too hard. We had a great time role playing scenarios where we can use our growth mindset to accomplish something hard!

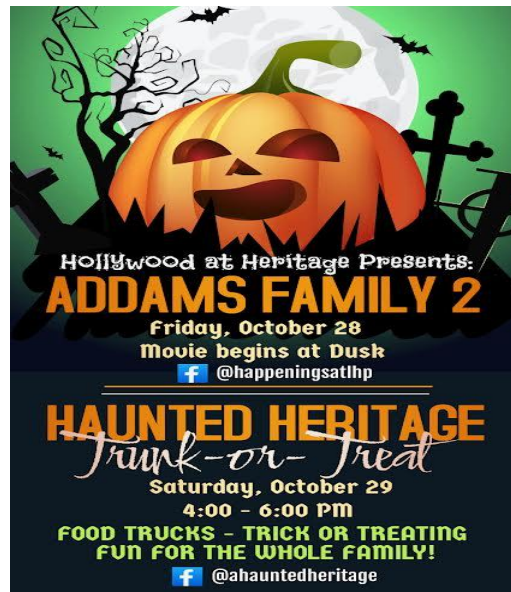
