Happy Friday, LES Families!!

This has been such a fun week! I hope that everyone had fun at their parties. I enjoyed seeing the kids have fun and meeting several parents and family members!


Kindergarten/1st: Both grades are working through the Little Spot Curriculum, which is designed to help children identify and express their feelings. Last time, we met Scribble spot and discussed what happens when our feelings get jumbled up. This week, we read, "A Little Spot of Feelings, Emotion Detective." We learned how to "spot" clues like facial expressions and body language to understand how someone else may be feeling. The kids did SUCH a good job with this. They had some of the best facial expressions throughout the lesson!

2nd- This week, we talked about our main emotions and the feelings that fall under each category. In second grade, we start challenging students for increased emotional intelligence and differentiating between just being "mad" and actually feeling "frustrated" or "disappointed." We had some really thoughtful discussions and the kids even showed great empathy as they listened to their classmate's feelings!
