Indiana Launches New Platform to Connect Eligible Students and Families with Math, Reading Tutoring

Eligible families [can now access the Indiana Learns family platform](#), an online portal where they can view their grant funds, see Learning Partner vendors, and schedule tutoring services for their qualifying student. Indiana Learns is a new statewide grant program that provides families, demonstrating both financial and academic need, with up to \$1,000 to spend on math and reading high-dosage tutoring and approved out-of-school academic programs for their students. Mrs. Steele's Counselor's Corner

Happy Friday, LES Families!

Kindergarten/First: Our kindergarten and first graders continue to work through the "Little Spot" curriculum. This week, we met "Peaceful Spot" and focused on feeling calm and relaxed. We talked about clues that our bodies and facial expressions give us to notice we are feeling calm. We also learned some deep breathing techniques to help us get back to a calm place. Students will be familiar with taking deep breaths in through your nose (smell the flower), holding for a few seconds and then slowly releasing through their mouths (blow the bubbles). We also had fun by changing our imagery- Mrs. Steele says, "Okay, we are holding out cup of hot chocolate. I want to smell it because it smells SOOOO good (take a deep breath in), but oh no, it's too hot to drink so we have to blow on it (slow, controlled breath out). Ask your kiddos if they can show you!

Second: This week, we began talking about what it means to be thankful and show gratitude. Mrs. Steele taught them that "Gratitude is an Attitude!" This means that we can *choose* to find the positive and good in any situation. I challenged them to come up with things they were grateful for in tough topics- garbage, thunderstorms, school, vegetables. They did such a great job and then got to fill out their own grateful turkey with things that they personally were grateful for. We had some very sweet answers like family, friends, their home, and food. We also had some really great honest answers- Christmas tree cakes, cheese fries, their tablets, and more!
